OVERVIEW

Under the supervision of the Director of Golf Maintenance, the Assistant Superintendent / Manager of Kellogg Golf Course is responsible for a number of specific tasks as outlined below.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Acting as manager in the absence of the Director of Golf Maintenance.
- Assisting in supervising all personnel reporting to the Director of Golf Maintenance.
- Assisting with budget preparation and maintenance.
- Staying current with the latest chemical and turf maintenance practices.
- Attending scheduled and special meetings pertaining to golf.
- Understanding all Peoria Park District rules and regulations, especially those pertaining to golf.
- Following all safety procedures that pertain to the duties performed. Supporting all aspects of the Park District's safety program.
- Performing all other duties as assigned.

SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATES WILL HAVE

- Minimum of a two-year degree from an accredited college, junior college, or university in agronomy, turf management, horticulture, or related field. Extensive experience may be taken into consideration in lieu of an educational requirement.
- Experience in golf course or fine turf grass maintenance operations. Working knowledge of golf course irrigation systems operation and maintenance.
- Understanding of basic turf grass management techniques and the biological foundations of turf grass.
- Working knowledge of pesticides and pesticide application techniques. Requires ability to obtain valid State of Illinois Pesticide Operators certificate.
- Knowledge of the game of golf.
- Ability to work harmoniously with the public and fellow employees in an enthusiastic and cooperative manner.
- Ability to communicate effectively in both speaking and writing.
- Ability to work weekends, evenings, and holidays.
- Valid Illinois State Driver's License.
- Membership in Teamsters Local Union No. 627 is required for this position.
